

18 inch Crochet Round Doll Purse



Materials Needed

- Size H or 5.00mm crochet hook
- Worsted Weight Yarn (size 4)
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle
- Measuring Tape
- Stitch Markers
- Supplies:

Optional Materials:

- Beads, Buttons, Tassels for decorative purposes

Stitch Abbreviations

- Ch-chain
- Sl St- Slip Stitch
- Sc- Single Crochet
- Dc- Double Crochet

Notes

- Chain two to start each round never counts as a stitch
- Bag is worked from the bottom up
- Written in U.S. Terms
- Stitch counts are at the end of each round
- I recommend using a stitch marker to mark the start of each round

Measurements:

- 2 Crochet Circles (Width) 3 ½ Inches
- Purse Length (Approximate) 9 ½ Inches

Pattern: (make 2)

Chain 3, Sl St to the starting Ch st in order to form a circle, Ch 2

Round 1: 12 Dc in the circle, Sl St to starting Ch, Ch 2 (12)

Round 2: 2 Dc in each St around, Sl St to starting Ch, Ch 2 (24)

Round 3: *1 Dc into the first st, 2 Dc into the next st, repeat from the * around, Sl St to starting Ch, tie off (36)

Leave Tails!

Holding both circles with tails lining up and the insides of your circles facing each other (I hold my tails in as I'm crocheting, then cut off the ends.)

Attach Yarn with Sl St, Ch 1, Sc around (26) (you should have 10 extra stitches for the purse opening)



Chain 60,

Round 1: (while making sure that your Ch isn't twisted) Skip over 10 stitches to leave an opening for your purse and Sc into the next St to join, Ch 1

Round 2: 1 Sc in each st including Ch stitches , all around your work, Sl St to the starting Ch, tie off!

Weave In Your Ends!
