Crochet Beanie with Neck Warmer



Materials Needed

- Size J or 5.75 Hook (For Bigger Hat Size, Use Size K or 6.5mm Crochet Hook)
- Worsted 4 Weight 100% Acrylic Yarn
 - (one skein of worsted 4 weight yarn (ex. Big twist value, Redheart Supersaver, etc. if you use variegated you may need two skeins of yarn)
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle
- Measuring Tape
- StitChMarkers
- 1 InChButtons (2)
- Snap On/Removable Pom Pom

StitChAbbreviations:

- Ch-Chain
- Sl St Slip Stitch
- DC Double Crochet

Notes:

- Ch2 at the start of eaChrow does not count as a stitCh
- Crochet pattern written in U.S. Terms
- Pattern is worked from the top of the hat down
- StitChcounts are at the end of eaChrow
- I recommend using stitChmarkers for this project

Crochet Beanie With Neck Warmer Measurements (Approximate):

- Length (Top of Hat to Bottom): 16 inches.
- Width (Measurements left to ride side of hat when finished): 10 inches.

Pattern:

Ch 3, sl st into beginning st, Ch 2 or do Round 1 into a magic ring

Round 1: 12 Dc into the circle, sl st into beginning st, Ch2. (12)

Round 2: 2 Dc into each st around, sl st into beginning st, Ch2 (24)

Round 3: *1 Dc into the first st, 2 Dc into the next st, repeat from the *around, sl st into beginning stitch, Ch2. (36)

Round 4: *1 Dc into the first 2 stitches, 2 Dc into the next st, repeat from the * around, sl st into beginning stitch, Ch2. (48)

Round 5: *1 Dc into the first 3 stitches, 2 Dc into the next st, repeat from the * around, sl st into beginning stitch, Ch2. (60)

Rounds 6-17: 1 Dc into each st around, sl st into beginning st, Ch2. (60)

Round 18: 1 Dc into the first 22 stitches, Ch 24, skip over 24 stitches, 1 Dc into the 25th st, 1 Dc into the next 13 stitches, sl st into beginning st, Ch2. (60) (See picture 1) **The total stitch count for round 18

The total stitch count for round 18 includes the 24 Ch stitches!

Round 19: 1 Dc into each st around, (including 1 Dc into the 24 Ch stitches), sl st into beginning st, Ch2. (60)

Rounds 20-32: 1 Dc into each st around, sl st into beginning st, Ch2. (60)

Round 33: 1 Dc into each st around, sl st into beginning st, (60)

Tie off

Hat Flap With two 1 inch buttons (optional)

With your hat laying down, facing you right side up, as shown in picture, attach yarn in first st, top right of eye opening part (see picture 2)
Ch2 (does not count as stitch)

Rows 1-4: 1 Dc into the 24 stitches across, Ch 2 (24)
Tie off, and weave in your ends.

Attach/sew two 1 inch buttons to hold your flap back, as shown in picture 3.

To finish the hat, attach Pom Pom to the top of the hat, if desired. Make sure to weave and sew in all of your ends to finish.
