Crochet Favor Bag



Materials Needed

- Size I or 5.25mm crochet hook
- Worsted Weight Yarn (size 4)
- Thin Ribbon
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle
- Measuring Tape
- Stitch Markers

Optional Materials:

• Beads, Tassels, Charms for decorative purposes

Stitch Abbreviations

- Ch-chain
- Sl St-Slip Stitch
- HDC-Half Double Crochet
- Dc- Double Crochet

Notes

- Chain two to start each round never counts as a stitch
- Bag is worked from the bottom up
- Written in U.S. Terms
- Stitch counts are at the end of each round
- I recommend using a stitch marker to mark the start of each round

Pattern:

Chain 28, Sl St to the starting Ch st in order to form a circle, Ch 2 (28)

Round 1: 1 HDC in each st around, Sl St to starting Ch, Ch 2 (28)

Rounds 2-14: 1 HDC in each st around, Sl St to starting Ch, Ch 2 (28)

Round: 15: 1 Dc in each st around, Sl St to starting Ch, Ch 2 (28)

Round 16: 1 Dc in each st around, Sl St to starting Ch, tie off!

Weave in ALL of your ends.

Ribbon Placement:

In the second row down, from the top of your bag, use thin ribbon or a few strands of yarn held together, starting from the front center of your bag, weave ribbon or yarn in and out in between each stitch and meet back in the front of your bag so you can make a bow in the front of your bag.

Add Beads, Tassels, Charms to accessorize your favor bag if you'd like!
