

# Crochet Small Dog, Cat Bed



## Materials Needed

- Size K or 6.5mm crochet hook
- Worsted Weight Yarn (size 4)
  - I used scrap yarns for mine
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle
- Measuring Tape
- St Markers

## St Abbreviations

- Ch-Ch
- Sl St- Slip St
- Dc-Double Crochet

- Dcblo- Double Crochet Back Loop only

## Notes

### Finished Measurements:

- Small Dog/Cat Bed: Base 14 inches width, Sides 4 ½ inches tall
- My rescue chihuahua mix dog (for size reference) tip of nose to start of tail – 20 inches, standing floor to top of back – 11 inches, weight approximately a little over 9 lbs.
- Ch 2 never counts as a St
- You can use any worsted 4 weight acrylic yarns
- Pattern is worked holding 3 strands of worsted 4 weight yarns together
- Stitches will be tightly Stitched because the bed will loosen just a little with time, three strands makes the bed more sturdy.
- (Side note – my chihuahua is rough with the bed, fluffing it, etc and it has stayed perfectly in tact!)
- Bed is worked starting with the base, then working up the sides.

### Pattern:

To Start, holding 3 strands of worsted 4 acrylic weight yarns together, Ch 3, sl st into first St

**Round 1:** Ch 2, work 12 Dc into circle, sl st into first Dc to close (12)

**Round 2:** Ch 2, work 2 Dc into each st around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (24)

**Round 3:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 2 dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (36)

**Round 4:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next St, 2 Dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (48)

**Round 5:** Ch 2: \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next 2 St, 2 Dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (60)

**Round 6:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next 3 St, 2 Dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (72)

**Round 7:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next 4 St, 2 Dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (84)

**Round 8:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next 5 St, 2 dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (96)

**Round 9:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next 6 St, 2 Dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (108)

**Round 10:** Ch 2, \*work 1 Dc in the first St, 1 Dc in the next 7 St, 2 Dc in the next St, repeat from the \* around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (120)

**Round 11:** Ch 2, 1 Dcblo in each St around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (120)

**Round 12-16:** Ch 2, 1 Dc in each St around the circle, sl st into first Dc to close (120)

*You can add more rows here if you want the sides of your pet bed taller, my rescue chihuahua dog seems to like this height, she can get in and out easily.*

Sl St, Tie Off, and Weave In Your Ends!
